Dear Parent/Guardian

In anticipation of schools re-opening in the very near future, we are contacting parents and guardians of the children who attend to remind you of your responsibilities about parking around the school.

You will have noticed that prior to schools closing, we completed patrols in relation to reports we had received of dangerous and inconsiderate driving and parking in the locality of the schools.

Parking restrictions are put in place to manage the roads and to ensure the safety of road users, vehicles and pedestrians. This is particularly important around schools.

This letter is being provided to remind drivers of the responsibilities they have to help promote safety around schools and to raise awareness of the possibility of parking tickets being issued to the minority of road users who may choose to ignore the parking restrictions in place.

For the avoidance of doubt the School Keep Clear marking (also known as yellow zig zag lines) provides a mandatory prohibition of stopping during the times shown. You should not stop on these markings, not even to pick up or set down children or passengers.

Please be assured that we will take action where required. This could result in a penalty notice being issued to you if you park against the restrictions.

Let's work together to keep our roads, and children, safe.
