

One and All After School Club

One and All After School Club offers a safe place for children, outside of school hours, to enable their parents to work, study or just have time to themselves.

What does the club offer?

The After School Club (ASC) provides a range of activities in a comfortable and safe environment. Arts and crafts, games and sport, story-telling and outdoor play are just some of the activities offered. There is an opportunity for homework and quiet play. Activities vary each day / week to meet the children's personal, social and emotional needs.

We aim to sit for snack/ light tea around 16.45 this includes a choice of sandwiches, wraps and pancakes and on occasions hot dogs or pizza.

How much does it cost?

We charge £11 per session (10% sibling discount only on a full session) £6 for a half session (up till 16.30) £7 entry after 16.30. We operate from 15.10 till 18.00hrs, term time only.

How do I know the club is up to scratch?

We are inspected annually & regulated by Ofsted. The certificate of registration and a copy of our insurance policy are always displayed at the club. All staff are required to be checked by the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) and we ensure that all appropriate ratios of qualified staff are present at all times.
