He was the Men's Doubles champion in the 2016 English National Badminton Championships. Together with Chris Langridge he won the Bronze Medal in the Men's Doubles at the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio de Janeiro. Marcus was accompanied by James Jennison of Premier Sports and together they led an assembly for all the children. They were fascinated by his story and a group of KS2 pupils were then given the opportunity to interview him further.
